1. Background & Rationale

Hyderabad, a major urban center in India, is witnessing an increasing number of people suffering from chronic health conditions such as **hypertension**, **diabetes**, and mobility issues due to aging and disabilities. According to studies, a significant portion of the population, especially the elderly, is unable to manage these conditions effectively due to lack of access to regular health monitoring tools, early detection, and necessary medical equipment. There is also a critical gap in the availability of low-cost, effective health tools such as **hypertension** monitoring devices, diabetes testing kits, and mobility aids.

This project aims to bridge that gap by providing essential health and mobility equipment to vulnerable populations in Hyderabad, ensuring they can better manage their health conditions and live independently.

2. Project Objectives

- To distribute hypertension testing kits, diabetes testing kits, and mobility aids to underserved populations in Hyderabad.
- To improve access to medical equipment for the elderly, people with disabilities, and individuals with chronic health conditions.
- To raise awareness on the importance of regular health monitoring for hypertension, diabetes, and overall well-being.
- To equip local healthcare centers and community-based organizations with the necessary tools for ongoing patient support.

3. Target Beneficiaries

- Elderly Population (60 years and above): Many elderly individuals suffer from hypertension, diabetes, and related mobility challenges.
- **People with Disabilities**: This group requires specialized medical equipment for health monitoring and support.
- Low-Income Households with Chronic Health Conditions: Individuals who have hypertension or diabetes but lack access to proper diagnostic tools and medical support.

4. Equipment to be distributed

1. Hypertension Testing Kits (Blood Pressure Monitors)

o **Quantity**: 500 units

 For individuals suffering from high blood pressure, ensuring they can monitor their health regularly and avoid complications.

2. Diabetes Testing Kits (Blood Glucose Monitors)

- o **Quantity**: 500 units
- For people with diabetes, to monitor their blood sugar levels and manage their condition effectively.

3. Glucose Strips

- o **Quantity**: 50,000 strips (to support continued use of the glucose monitors)
- o To ensure the availability of consumables for diabetes testing.

4. Wheelchairs

- o **Quantity**: 200 units
- To aid individuals with mobility challenges, particularly elderly and disabled individuals.

5. Walkers

o **Quantity**: 150 units

 To provide additional mobility support to individuals with limited walking ability.

6. **4-Legged Walking Sticks**

Quantity: 150 units

For individuals who need extra stability and support while walking.

7. Nebulizers

o **Quantity**: 100 units

To assist individuals with respiratory issues, particularly elderly individuals with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) or asthma.

8. Lumbar Support Belts (LS Belts)

- o **Quantity**: 200 units
- o To provide back support for individuals suffering from chronic back pain.

5. Project Activities and Implementation Plan

Phase 1: Needs Assessment and Planning (1 Month)

- Conduct surveys and field visits to identify key areas of need, focusing on elderly communities, low-income households, and areas with high prevalence of diabetes and hypertension.
- Collaborate with local hospitals, healthcare professionals, and community leaders to identify eligible beneficiaries.
- Establish partnerships with suppliers for procurement of equipment and consumables.

Phase 2: Procurement and Logistics (2 Months)

- Finalize contracts with suppliers for the purchase of testing kits, mobility aids, and other equipment.
- Organize transportation and storage of the equipment in a central warehouse in Hyderabad.
- Set up distribution channels with local healthcare providers and NGOs for outreach to vulnerable communities.

Phase 3: Distribution and Awareness Campaign (6 Months)

- Begin the distribution of testing kits (hypertension and diabetes) and mobility aids through healthcare centers, NGO partners, and community organizations.
- Conduct educational workshops and awareness sessions in targeted communities about hypertension, diabetes management, and the use of the equipment.
- Provide training on how to use the equipment effectively, especially blood pressure monitors, glucose meters, and nebulizers.

Phase 4: Ongoing Support, Monitoring, and Follow-up (3 Months)

- Regular follow-up visits to ensure proper usage and to collect feedback on the effectiveness of the equipment.
- Establish a helpline or WhatsApp group for beneficiaries to seek guidance on health monitoring.
- Collect data on health improvements and challenges faced by the beneficiaries.

Phase 5: Impact Assessment and Evaluation (Final Month)

- Conduct surveys and interviews to evaluate the impact of the distribution program on the health outcomes of beneficiaries.
- Assess the sustainability of the program and explore opportunities for continued support and expansion.
